I. KEY RESULTS OF ACTIVITIES OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY

2019

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was created to form a public integration model of the Greater Eurasian partnership. It is intended to become a platform for uniting the efforts of non-governmental organizations in approving the ideas of peacemaking, interethnic and interfaith dialogue, expanding business, cultural and humanitarian cooperation.

Eurasia is home to three-quarters of the world's population. Eurasia and its peoples are the cradle of human civilization. That's where mordern culture came from, its material and spiritual values. Eurasia is the birthplace of world religions. The world economy is also based on the economic power of Europe and Asia. However, the main wealth of Eurasia lies in the diversity and uniqueness of its peoples' cultures, in the basic spiritual and moral values, in the common desire for peace for all the peoples.

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly implements diverse projects aimed at strengthening integration processes through peace-making dialogue, public diplomacy and multilateral cooperation with partners from different countries of Greater Eurasia.

Today, representatives of more than 40 countries of the continent are members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

People's diplomacy is a strategic resource for the development of all states cooperation. Using the language of people's diplomacy, it is easier to build bridges of understanding, relying on deep roots of national traditions. Its effective implementation is designed to humanize international relations.

Dozens of cooperation agreements have been signed with business organizations, Chambers of Commerce, higher education institutions, foundations, research centers, various public organizations and associations from India, France, Serbia, Syria, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Bulgaria, Russia, Mongolia, Azerbaijan and other Eurasian countries.

The Assembly focuses on issues of economic cooperation, culture, sports, education and youth policy. The program of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly includes various international projects and events.

The practice of holding the Days of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in different countries has proved to be positive. Traditionally, the international delegation of the Assembly includes representatives from different countries, including representatives of the diplomatic corps of the Eurasian countries, international intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations, well-known figures of culture, science, education, and youth.

The idea of Eurasian integration, demonstrated at the events of the Assembly, helps to form equal and respectful relations between countries and recognition of the deep identity of the eurasian peoples.

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is open for the widest dialogue and cooperation and is ready for joint creative and business projects. The Assembly implements such megaprojects as the Assembly Days in different countries, the youth project "EURASIA KIDS", the sports project "EURASIADA" and the project "VICTORIOUS TOGETHER", dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the Great Victory.

Nowadays our continent is in peril of the ever-emerging hotbeds of political and military conflicts. The international situation is strained and complex in the context of the formation of a multi-polar world. Therefore, such a unifying peacekeeping project as the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is reclaimed by the life itself. The idea of peaceful coexistence is close and understandable to all people.

Mutual understanding is possible only when people accept and respect the values of each other on which their worldview is based. The transmission of these values to the consciousness of peoples of other cultures in the forms by which they could be better understood and accepted, is most successfully achieved through intercultural communication, thanks to international humanitarian and economic cooperation.

Each event held by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly carries a creative impulse, a peacemaking message, the affirmation of culture and the strengthening of friendship between peoples.

In the future, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly has an important task of expanding and strengthening international multilateral cooperation, giving this work a systemic character and new conceptualization, developping of innovative approaches, bearing in mind the rapidly changing realities of the modern world.

- Support of public and state initiatives aimed at preserving peace and harmony, strengthening friendship and interethnic neighborliness;
- unification of efforts for the preservation of the Eurasian continent in all the diversity of its natural, spiritual, cultural, historical heritage and the creation of safe and comfortable living conditions;
- implementation of new interaction formats and the creation of an effective partnership between the Assembly and civil society institutions and authorities of the countries of Eurasia;
- development and implementation of the programs, projects and events, connected with statutory activities of the Assembly, which are aimed at strengthening of cooperation between peoples of Eurasia;
- creation of opportunities and favorable conditions for exercising resource potential of each person, who is striving to contribute significantly into development of Eurasia.

II. MEETINGS OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY

February 1, Russia, Moscow




The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly held an extended meeting of the General Council at the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation.

The main task of the meeting was to summarize the work of the Assembly for 2018, as well as to approve the Activity Plan for 2019. More than 250 representatives from 20 countries of Eurasia attended the event. Among the participants were representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, Rossotrudnichestvo, the Federation

Council, the State Duma, the Moscow Government, the EEC, the BRICS Alliance, the CIS Executive Committee, the Union State, EDB, scientists, artists, business representatives of Eurasia. During the meeting, there were signed bilateral cooperation agreements between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Research Center for Eurasian Integration, International Alliance of BRICS Strategic Projects, the Russian-Turkish Business Council under the RF CCI, the Russian-Qatari Business Council under the RF CCI, the Egyptian-Russian Foundation for Culture and Science and other organizations.

November 15, Russia, St. Petersburg



An extended meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly took place in the House of Friendship of the Leningrad Region,

The General Council heard the reports of the Head of the Representative office of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in the Leningrad region Yuri Palamarchuk, Chairman of the Council of Composers and Musicians of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Baturin; Chairman of the Ancestral Culture Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Larissa Dokuchaeva on the activities of the structural units of the Assembly led

by them. The General Council approved the projects "Discover Eurasia" and "Friendship Lessons" of the Eurasian Youth Assembly; "Symphony of Love" and "Verona Music and Poetry Festival"; "WORLD - My Family History" of the Ancestral Culture Council; and "SMIrotvorets (Mass Media Peacemaker) - Eurasia". These projects were assigned the status of "Supported by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly". It was decided to approve the Assembly project "Library of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly". The extended meeting of the General Council finished with the presentation of Membership Certificates to the new members of the Assembly and the signing of a Cooperation Agreement between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the non-profit organization "Association for International Social Development" (Bulgaria).

III. MEETINGS OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL PRESIDIUM OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY

May 22, Bulgaria, Sofia

Chaired by the Assembly's Secretary General Andrei Belyaninov there was held another extended meeting of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The Presidium received a welcome message on behalf of Anatoly Makarov the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Russian Federation to the Republic of Bulgaria. The welcome message was presented by the Head of the Rossotrudnichestvo Representative Office in the Republic of Bulgaria, Director of The Russian Cultural and Information Center in Sofia Irina Zhivikhina.



The Presidium listened to the reports of the Spiritual Culture Council and the Council on Film and Video Visualization of the Cultural and Historical Space of Eurasia. The Presidium approved new projects: "International Marketing Competition in the Tourist Industry "PRObrand", "III Festival of Physical Culture of peoples of Russia and Eurasia - "Russian World", cycling expedition "Belts and Ways of Eurasia", International film festival "A Good Film", "The Sun Museum" and the project – "In the Name of Peace and Creation", dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the Victory in the Great Patriotic war and the Second World war.

Developing the strategy of the Assembly activities, the General Council Presidium has decided to create a new structural unit - Business Club.

According to the established tradition, the new members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the majority of them are from Bulgaria, were presented membership Certificates at the Presidium.

Signing of Cooperation Agreements was an important part of the meeting of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The first agreement was signed between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Union of Bulgarian Journalists. Andrey Belyaninov - General Secretary of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and Snezhana Todorova - Chairman of the Union of Bulgarian Journalists, signed it. Also there were signed Cooperation Agreements between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Association for the development of European cultural and economic relations "Bulgarian Center" (singed by the Vice-President Vyacheslav Dumenko), "Eurasian Institute of Geopolitics and Economics of St. Cyprian" (singed by the Chairman of the Board Plamen Miletkov).

Representatives of Russia, Bulgaria, India, France, Serbia, Kyrgyzstan, Turkey and Mongolia attended the meeting. The meeting of the General Council Presidium of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was held at the National Palace of Culture of the Republic of Bulgaria.

September 30, Azerbaijan, Baku

An extended meeting of the Presidium of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was chaired by Svetlana Smirnova, the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.

In accordance with the agenda, the members of the Presidium considered the positive results of the first year of the Representative Office of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in the Sverdlovsk Region, listened to the report of the Council on International Cultural cooperation of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, and approved a new Specialized Council on Science and Higher education.

The General Council Presidium heard a report on the successful holding of the International Youth Forum in



Kyrgyzstan. Also it approved Daria Saprynskaya, Deputy Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly for Youth Cooperation, as the Chairman of the Coordinating Council of the Eurasian Youth Assembly.




The members of the Presidium considered and approved the new project of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly "Eurasian Academy of Public Diplomacy". The status "Supported by the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" was assigned to new thematic projects "Theatrical Eurasia", "Great Patriotic war. Chronicle of the war through the eyes of front-line artists", "Victory Marathon", "Sochi International Film Festival, Film Prize IRIDA (SIFFA)" and the project "Engineers of the XXI Century".

Traditionally, at the General Council Presidium the new members of the Assembly from different countries got the membership Certificates. The Presidium finished its work with the signing of three cooperation agreements between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the International Association of Bloggers, the National Forum of Non-Governmental Organizations of Azerbaijan, and the International Mugham Center.

IV. SIGNING OF COOPERATION AGREEMENTS

January 22, Russia, Moscow



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Russian Union of Martial Arts signed a cooperation agreement. The Executive Director of the RUMA Ramil Gabbasov and Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Alexander Muromsky signed the document. The agreement implies the promotion of a healthy lifestyle principles and mass sports, strengthening ties in order to implement the common goals of public associations in the field of physical culture and sports, national sports, as well as martial arts.

January 30, Russia, Kaluga



The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Ministry of Internal Policy and Mass communications of the Kaluga region of the Russian Federation signed a cooperation agreement in the Innovative Cultural Center in Kaluga. The First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat - Svetlana Smirnova Minister of Internal Policy and and Communications of the Kaluga region - Oleg Kalugin signed the document. The parties agreed to provide each other with wider assistance, using the unique integration potential of public diplomacy, the system


of equal international partnership, exchange of experience and dialogue.

February 25, Russia, Moscow

February 25, Russia, Moscow

February 25, Russia, Moscow

March 15, Russia, Moscow

March 18, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and Autonomous Organization the "Eurasian Academy of Television and Radio" signed a partnership agreement on the joint holding of the annual Sevastopol International Festival of Documentary Films and Television Programs "Victorious Together" and the Eurasian Congress to preserve the memory and prevent falsification of the results of the Second World war in the countries of Eurasia.

April 18, Russia, Moscow



An agreement on cooperation was signed between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Association of Entrepreneurs of the Assembly of the Peoples of Kazakhstan.

The document was signed by Svetlana Smirnova, the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and Bolat Sarsenov, Deputy Chairman of the Association of Legal Entities "Association of Entrepreneurs of the Assembly of the Peoples of Kazakhstan".

May 2, Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek

May 14, Russia, Moscow

The parties also agreed that the deputies of the Committee would take part in significant events of the Assembly, such as the Days of the Assembly in Eurasian countries.

May 13, Russia, Moscow

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Standing Committee of Union state have signed a cooperation agreement. Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and Yury Rapota, State Secretary of the Union state signed the agreement.

The agreement provides for interaction in the preservation and expansion of Belarusian-Russian ties and ties of the peoples of Eurasia in the field of economic, scientific, technical and cultural activities, assistance in the formation of organizational, economic, legal and other conditions for strengthening the unity of the Eurasian peoples, inter-regional cooperation. Both sides agreed that it is necessary to intensify cultural and humanitarian cooperation to preserve the ethno-cultural identity, spiritual and moral ideals of people.

May 20, Bulgaria, Plovdiv



The agricultural forum "Integration of the Eurasian countries - a factor in the development of the agricultural market" was held at the Agrarian University (Plovdiv) during the Days of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in the Republic of Bulgaria.

Following the forum, a cooperation agreement was signed between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Agrarian University, Plovdiv.

May 22, Bulgaria, Sofia





May 24, Russia, Moscow

June 8, Russia, St. Petersburg

June 13, Russia, Moscow

Andrei Belyaninov, General Secretary of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, met with Metropolitan Hilarion of Volokolamsk. The meeting was held in the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate on the territory of the Danilov Monastery. The Monastery was founded at the end of the 13th century by the Moscow Prince Danill Alexandrovich. Today it is the spiritual and administrative center of the Russian Orthodox Church. The theme of bilateral cooperation between the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the Department for External Church Relations of the Moscow Patriarchate





July 10, Mongolia, Ulaanbaatar

July 29, Russia, Moscow


May 2, Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek

July 4, Russia, Moscow



It was decided that such an expert platform should become regular; the next meeting is to be held in Bishkek.

Non-Governmental organizations the "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" in the Sverdlovsk region.

In this regard, it was proposed to develop a "road map" to intensify integration processes in the Caspian region.

October 3, Azerbaijan, Baku






October 22, Russia, Moscow

July 18–19, Russia, Moscow

The Presidential Commissioner for Children's Rights, Anna Kuznetsova, and the Deputy Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, Chairman of the Association of Universities of Greater Eurasia Mikhail Fedorov took part in the Conference. Orenburg (Russia), Kustanay – Nur-Sultan – Pavlodar (Kazakhstan), Burchun – Hami – Lanzhou – Yinchuan – Datong – Beijing (China). The scientist and traveler planned to explore and promote the humanitarian aspects of the interface of the Chinese initiative "One Belt - One Way" and the EAEU. By his project, the scientist promoted the ideas and values of Eurasian integration, protection of peace, strengthening of friendship, harmony, partnership and good neighborliness between peoples.

Maxim Mikhalev traveled alone on a bicycle eight thousand kilometers from Moscow to Beijing in exactly 100 days.

"Last year, I published at the "Nauka" Publishing House in collaboration with Vladimir Yakunin, President of the "Dialogue of Civilizations" World Public Forum, a book on integration processes in Eurasia, including the "One Belt - One Way" initiative - said Maxim Mikhalev. — Then an idea had arisen to look at the same problem from the point of view of a simple traveler and see how everything really looks like. As a result, the idea of such a project was born, that is a "bicycle expedition" to collect materials for the second volume of the book".

Maxim Mikhalev's expedition finished in Beijing on September 1. "There are quite a lot of conclusions: for a whole book, - said Maxim Mikhalev. — There are many unexpected observations that are difficult to generalize immediately. The main thing is that a bicycle trip as a method of scientific research, which has never been attempted, makes sense and, indeed, is justified".

May 28, Russia, Yekaterinburg

300 young citizens of the Russian Federation and 500 young citizens of foreign countries became forum

participants in 2019. The forum program included a business part, a part for participants to interact and a creative program. emphasized that the discussion of the issues of Altai civilization among young people is a continuation of the search for common spiritual and cultural roots of the Eurasian peoples, which began in Kyrgyzstan in 2017 at the First International forum "Altai Civilization and Related Peoples of the Altai Language Family". September 25–26, Kyrgyz Republic, Bishkek

For three days, the young people worked at various sites in the ALA-ARCHA state residence. "Eurasian Week 2019" comprised 25 business and 5 special events. More than 200 speakers with speeches on topical issues of the EAEU integration into the global market, joint projects of the agro-industrial complex, a single energy market.

A separate block of the "Eurasian Week" program was devoted to the youth agenda: educational programs, business games and support for young entrepreneurs. The "EAEU Young Leader School" brought together youth activists and aspiring diplomats from participating countries.

October 2–3, Azerbaijan, Baku

The Forum of the Eurasian Youth Assembly was held at the Azerbaijan State Economic University and the Azerbaijan National Conservatory. Daria Saprynskaya, Chairman of the Eurasian Youth Assembly and a graduate student at Moscow State University made a speech at the conference.


