I. KEY RESULTS OF THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY ACTIVITIES

2022

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly continues to confidently take shape as an international platform that affirms the ideology of benevolent good neighborliness of different countries and peoples.

At the end of the reporting period members of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly are **851** individuals and **72** legal entities, representatives of non-governmental organizations from **46** countries. In 2022, **83** new members joined the Assembly.

In the period between the General Assemblies, the General Council is the collegial executive body of the Assembly, which implements the tasks set. The General Council of the Assembly includes well-known public figures from 33 countries of Greater Eurasia: Austria, Azerbaijan, Armenia, Benin, Bulgaria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Vietnam, Germany, Georgia, Denmark, Egypt, Iran, Spain, Italy, Kazakhstan, Cameroon, China, Kyrgyzstan, Lithuania, Macedonia, Moldova, Palestine, Russia, Serbia, Slovenia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Finland, France, Montenegro, Czech Republic, Switzerland.

Having celebrated its first anniversary in the reporting year, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly has undoubtedly moved to a new qualitative level: in 5 years it has become a well-known international communication platform for interaction between civil society institutions and authorities.

Developing a broad partnership, the Assembly seeks to implement diverse projects through peacekeeping dialogue, public diplomacy, mutually beneficial cooperation with partners from different countries of Greater Eurasia. This balanced line finds active support not only in the circles of the international community, but also in the authorities of different countries. At a time when many values that were provided by state international treaties are collapsing, people's diplomacy, the content of this concept, takes on a new meaning.

Among the priority areas of public diplomacy used by the Assembly in the reporting period are:

- scientific and educational cooperation, projects in the sphere of education and science;
- cultural and humanitarian cooperation, projects dedicated to common history, spiritual and moral values, humanitarian security, cultural exchanges, promotion of the Russian language and diplomacy of happiness;
 - economic cooperation, partnership based on trust and striving for economic integration;
 - youth, children's and sports cooperation.

At the site of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, specialized international councils are actively operating. Their sphere of attention also includes issues of scientific, economic, cultural cooperation, tasks in the field of education and sports.

In its practical activities, the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly widely supports international projects of various kinds, including the implementation of the mega-projects EURASIA KIDS, "IMMORTAL MEMORY", "THERE IS HAPPINESS".

Among the main organizational tasks of the Assembly, the formation of the Representative Offices of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly is being gradually implemented. Representations have been established in the Leningrad, Sverdlovsk, Kaluga regions, in the city of Sevastopol, in the Republic of Bashkortostan and in the Republic of Crimea. In 2022, Assembly Representative Offices were opened in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and in the Republic of South Ossetia.

The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly continues to expand interaction with partners from different countries. During the reporting period, 40 cooperation agreements were concluded. In general, since its establishment, the Assembly has signed 177 agreements with business organizations, chambers of commerce and industry, higher educational institutions, foundations, research centers, various public organizations and associations from India, France, Serbia, Greece, Syria, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Turkey, Bulgaria, Russia, Azerbaijan, England, Italy, Spain, Benin and other countries.

The annual activity program of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly includes activities aimed at strengthening integration processes, within which relations between countries and peoples develop much more intensively than on a bilateral basis. Integration expands the space with favorable conditions for interaction not only through new members, but also through additional forms of international cooperation.

In the reporting period, the task of forming constructive interaction with supranational integration organizations was actively implemented. A number of events of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly were held with the active support of UNESCO, the SCO, the EAEU, the CIS, the Union State and other international organizations. A program of strategic partnership with the EEC was signed. Cooperation agreements have been signed with the Center for Public Diplomacy of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization in Uzbekistan, the SCO Friendship and Cooperation Center in Tajikistan. Joint events were carried out through UNESCO, EAEC, BRICS+, SCO with the organization of independent platforms of the Assembly within the events.

It is people's diplomacy that considers all the diversity of cultures and respects the traditions of different peoples, that makes it possible to more flexibly find solutions to problems that are relevant to the whole society. First of all, it is a peaceful life. This is the upbringing and happy future of all children, these are scientific and educational projects that advance humanity along the evolutionary path. These are issues of clean water, clean air, food safety and ecology. And many other topics to which neither the authorities nor the public of any country can remain indifferent.



II. THE EURASIAN PEOPLES' ASSEMBLY - 5 YEARS

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" in honor of its 5th anniversary held in Moscow the International Forum of People's Diplomacy in the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation. More than 500 representatives of public organizations, business, science, culture, sports, media, government, political and public figures took part in the forum. The purpose of the forum was to further develop the role of public diplomacy and expand Eurasian integration based on the coordination of the

activities of civil societies and authorities of the states of the continent. The issues of popularization and further development of public diplomacy through innovative approaches and modern mechanisms of cultural, humanitarian, scientific, educational and business cooperation were put on the agenda.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation hosted a plenary session "Public Diplomacy. New mechanisms for building a common future" of the International Forum of People's Diplomacy, dedicated to the fifth anniversary of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The main leitmotif of the meeting was the agreement of the participants that in modern conditions the unity of the peoples of the Eurasian continent is becoming an urgent need for the further development of a multi-level

integration model - Greater Eurasian Partnership. The Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrei Belyaninov thanked the participants for the formation of very important ideas, thoughts and meanings and for wide dissemination of these ideas not only on the Eurasian continent, but throughout the world.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



An International Panel session "The role of scientific diplomacy in supporting sustainable development" was held within the International Forum of People's Diplomacy organized by the Department of Sustainable Development of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The session was attended by prominent public figures, representatives of international organizations, scientific, financial and business structures of the countries of the Middle East and North Africa, Europe and Asia.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The panel session "Eurasian Partnership: New Protocols of Interaction", organized by the Department of Sustainable Development of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, has become one of the most controversial platforms of the International People's Diplomacy Forum, providing an opportunity to present their views to representatives of Europe, Asia, the Middle East and North Africa on the search for new forms interaction in order to achieve equal and mutually beneficial Eurasian

cooperation in the conditions of the modern world configuration.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The Panel session "Spiritual Culture: A Man of the Future" was held within the International Forum of Public Diplomacy. The session was organized by the Council for Spiritual Culture of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly and the International Center for Spiritual Culture. The purpose of the platform was to search for forms of spiritual harmony among the peoples of Greater Eurasia, to strengthen the role of spiritual and moral values, to expand the experience of applying the

foundations of spiritual culture in social practice. The panel session was held in a hybrid format. Among the participants were representatives of seven countries: Austria, Bulgaria, Germany, India, Russia, Mongolia, Uzbekistan.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation hosted the Panel session "People's Diplomacy: Traditions and Innovations". The discussion highlighted traditional and innovative methods and approaches in the search for new forms of interaction aimed at maintaining peace, harmony and public diplomacy for the development of a multi-level integration model - a Greater Eurasian partnership. Representatives of Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Italy, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Russia,

Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, France took part in the panel session.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



At the International Forum of Public Diplomacy devoted to the 5th anniversary of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the Panel session "Business diplomacy: from people's trust to the trust of economies" took place. The participants supported the expediency and necessity of strengthening friendly relations and trust between people, as this contributes to the development of business and all other aspects of interaction.

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation hosted the Panel session "Diplomacy of Happiness" of the International Forum of Public Diplomacy of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. More than a hundred representatives of Azerbaijan, Belarus, Vietnam, Israel, Kazakhstan, China, Russia, Uzbekistan, and South Korea took an active part in the session. The discussion was supported by leaders of non-governmental organizations, public opinion leaders, representatives of government bodies,

the scientific and educational community, representatives of youth associations, and journalists. The result of the session was the creation of a working group "Managing a happy and prosperous future".

June 3, Russia, Moscow



The Panel session "Public Diplomacy. Preservation of historical memory. Link between generations." Representatives of twelve countries took part in the event in a hybrid format: Bulgaria, Germany, Latvia, Lithuania, Kazakhstan, Canada, Moldova, Russia, Slovenia, USA, Uzbekistan, Estonia. The issues of forming a media space of historical memory and involving young people in the preservation of historical heritage were also considered at the session "Information"

diplomacy. Media and social networks". The purpose of the platforms is to search for new forms of unity of the peoples of the Eurasian continent on the basis of historical and cultural unity, the development of innovative mechanisms for involving young generations in the assertion of historical truth as a factor in building a common Eurasian future by means of public diplomacy.

November



The Commission of the Russian Federation for UNESCO dedicated a special issue of the regular edition "UNESCO Bulletin" to the activities of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The issue is devoted both to an overview of the outcomes of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly's work since its establishment in May 2017, and to future plans. This issue of the journal emphasizes the diversity and scale of the programs of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly aimed at strengthening friendship between peoples and maintaining peaceful relations in the Eurasian space.

IV. MEETINGS OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL AND COORDINATING COMMITTEES

February 11, Russia, Moscow



In Moscow, at the headquarters of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly", the annual meeting of the General Council was held in offline and online formats. The event was attended by members of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, as well as invited guests and partners. Anticipating the speeches of the meeting participants, Andrei Belyaninov, Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, noted that the international union had learned to work effectively

even in a pandemic, and also recalled the General Assembly of Eurasian Peoples held on July 9, 2021. It adopted a number of decisions important for the further development of the Assembly. In particular, changes were made to the Statute, a new composition of the General Council was elected for the next four years. The Supreme Advisory Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was established.

The plans include further expansion of the geography of activities, intensification of work with large international integration associations, such as the UN, SCO, BRICS, ASEAN, EAEU and others. Andrey Belyaninov emphasized the importance of the humanitarian component of Eurasian integration and the need for the development of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in this area. The participants of the General Council meeting considered the outcomes of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in 2021 and the activity plan for 2022, which were presented by the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General Secretariat Svetlana Smirnova.

February 25, online

The main topic of the agenda was the discussion of the tasks and prospects for the development of the Specialized Councils of the Assembly for 2022. September 27, online

The main issue of discussion was the topic of creating conditions for international cooperation of non-governmental organizations and promoting their consolidation through the activities of the Representative Offices of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly

November 15, Russia, Moscow



A meeting of the Coordinating Committee of the Specialized Councils of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly was held. The main topic of the agenda of the meeting was the discussion of tasks in the areas of activity of the Specialized Councils of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The participants of the meeting made proposals on establishing diplomatic and economic relations with partners from the countries of Eurasia, and also discussed new ideas for the development and

promotion of projects of Specialized Councils within the Union State, the CIS Executive Committee, the Eurasian Economic Commission and the SCO.

V. SIGNING OF AGREEMENTS WITH PARTNERS

February 11, online



The International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Congress of European Azerbaijanis signed a cooperation agreement within the framework of the meeting of the General Council of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly. The agreement was signed online using videoconferencing by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the President of the Congress of European Azerbaijanis Sahil Gasimov. The

organizations agreed to jointly promote the expansion and strengthening of international business cooperation, encourage the exchange of experience and information in the field of tourism, trade, industry, investment, and technological innovation.

February 11, online



As part of the General Council meeting of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Federal State Educational Budgetary Institution of Higher Education "Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation" signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the Rector of the Financial

University under the Government of the Russian Federation Stanislav Prokofiev. The parties agreed to join efforts to intensify international cooperation in scientific, educational and cultural activities in the interests of sustainable development.

March 17, Russia, Moscow



In the Civic Chamber of the Russian Federation, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "The Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Autonomous Non-Profit Organization "Scientific and Methodological Center for the Development and Support of Educational and Socio-Economic Programs and Projects "My Country" signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the First Deputy Secretary General - Head of the General

Secretariat of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Svetlana Smirnova and Chairman of the "My Country" Center Larisa Pastukhova. The parties agreed to develop international relations aimed at supporting public, state peacekeeping initiatives, joint implementation of socially significant programs and projects in scientific, educational and cultural activities.

March 22, Russia, Moscow

At the headquarters of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in Moscow, an agreement on cooperation was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Association for Assistance in Protecting the Rights of Pakistanis. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the Chairman of the Association for Assistance in Protecting the Rights of Pakistanis Malik



Shahbaz. The subject of the agreement is the implementation of interaction aimed at deepening partnerships between the peoples of different countries; increasing the role of public diplomacy in ensuring trust and mutual understanding between states.

March 23, Russia, Moscow

At the headquarters in Moscow, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the International Research Center of the Second World War in the city of Maribor (IC "Maribor") signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the General Director of the MIC "Maribor" Janez Uychich. As part of the agreement, the parties plan to hold joint events, develop



and implement educational programs, assist in the improvement of long-term and comprehensive scientific relations between organizations from different countries.

April 4, Russia, Moscow

At the headquarters of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly in Moscow, an agreement on information cooperation was signed between the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Non-Commercial Partnership "National Business Partnership "Alliance Media". The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the President of Alliance-Media Igor Gorodnichiy. The



subject of the agreement was cooperation aimed at information support, support and development of information exchange and preservation of historical memory based on the use of modern technologies.

April 18, Russia, Moscow



At the headquarters in Moscow, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Joint-Stock Company "Faraday Company" signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the President of the "Faraday Company" Svetlana Andrianova. The purpose of the agreement is the expansion of international business cooperation, as well

as the exchange of accumulated experience in the following areas: tourism, commercial and industrial environment, exports, imports, finance, measures to stimulate investment activity of Eurasian countries.

April 28, Russia, Moscow



Chairman of the Board of the All-Russian Association for the Development of Local Self-Government Ivan Tsetsersky and Secretary General of the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" Andrey Belyaninov signed a cooperation agreement. The signing took place within the All-Russian Municipal Forum. The interaction of organizations will be aimed at deepening partnerships between the peoples of different countries, the joint

implementation of socially significant programs, projects and cultural and educational events in the field of international cooperation.

May 11, Uzbekistan, Tashkent



International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the **Economic** Assembly of Uzbekistan signed memorandum of cooperation on May 11 in Tashkent, on the sidelines of the Forum of People's Diplomacy of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO). The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the Chairman of the Economic Assembly of Uzbekistan

Mukhtor Umarov. The purpose of the memorandum is to strengthen international business cooperation, exchange of information on investments, innovations, state and public mechanisms to support entrepreneurs.

May 11, Uzbekistan, Tashkent



On the sidelines of the Forum of People's Diplomacy of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO), held in Tashkent, the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the Public Foundation "Ibn Sino" signed a cooperation agreement. The agreement was signed by the Secretary General of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly Andrey Belyaninov and the Chairman of the Board of the Public Fund "Ibn Sino" Nozimkhon Makhmudov. The

objectives of the foundation are to hold international symposiums, conferences, congresses dedicated to the study of the scientific and spiritual heritage of Ibn Sina (Avicenna).

May 11, Uzbekistan, Tashkent



On the sidelines of the Forum of People's Diplomacy of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO), the International Union of Non-Governmental Organizations "Eurasian Peoples' Assembly" and the SCO Friendship and Cooperation Center in Tajikistan signed a memorandum of cooperation. Tajikistan Abdukhalil Gafurzoda. The main activities of the center are the strengthening of cooperation and friendship, the promotion of mutual trust and good neighborliness, solidarity between peoples and religions, the development of a dialogue of civilizations.





and Central Africa, as well as to discuss a number of existing and planned projects of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly.


April 26, Uzbekistan, Tashkent





friendship houses and national cultural centers.




September 21, Switzerland, Geneva


October 4-5, Russia, Moscow


souvenirs for the Christmas Charity Lottery.





IX. YOUTH AND CHILDREN COOPERATION


January 15, France, Paris


August 26, Kyrgyzstan, Bishkek







XI. IN LIEU OF CONFINEMENT

At the same time, while developing the activities of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly, as before, it is necessary to remember and emphasize the humanitarian component of Eurasian integration - respect for the common history, spiritual and moral values, mutual enrichment of cultures of different peoples, the desire for joint development, cordial human relations.

The previous five-year period has confirmed the need for closer interaction with the Assembly's partners in a variety of areas.

An important task of the Assembly is to further intensify work on the Eurasian agenda together with major international integration organizations such as the UN, SCO, EAEU, SG, BRICS and others. It is necessary to further expand the formats and types of unifying platforms in the context of public diplomacy.

At the same time, it is important not only to improve the existing instruments of international public cooperation, but also to promote the emergence of new formats. People's diplomacy can capture new trends to unite people's forces around the world, promote the advantages of having reliable partners, new areas of activity, additional communication channels, be flexible, actively expand diplomatic relations, and strengthen multilateral cooperation at the international level.

This constructive partnership is fully consistent with the goals and objectives of the Eurasian Peoples' Assembly as the International Union of non-governmental organizations and citizens with an active life position, sharing and promoting the ideas and values of Eurasian integration, protection of peace, strengthening friendship, partnership and good neighborliness among peoples.
